

Quilter's Academy *Standard Class Supply List*

The following will serve as your check list for almost any class you take, anywhere. Tape it to the wall of your sewing room so you can review it before class.

Clean your machine and install a new needle. Wind 2 or 3 bobbins. Bring extra empty bobbins.

Replace that dull rotary blade with a nice new one.

Always carry your machines manual with your machine. Don't forget power cords and foot controllers. Be sure your machine is in good working order.

Standard supplies to bring to most classes;

Rotary Cutter

Note Pad and Mechanical Pencil

Cutting Mat

Neutral Thread to Blend with Background

Various Size Rulers

Scissors and Thread Snips

Seam Ripper

Fabric Marking Pens or Pencils

Stiletto

Iron and Pressing Surface

Glass Head Straight Pins

Magic Sizing or Niagara Sizing

Masking Tape and Small Bag

Fabric Scraps To Test Tension

Extra Machine Needles MicroTex 60, 70, 80 & 90 Are Good to Carry

A Seat Cushion is Helpful for Your Back and Shoulders

Machine Feet; ¼" For Piecing. Walking Foot and Free Motion Foot, also know as an Embroidery or Darning Foot, these are for machine quilting. An Open Toe Applique Foot, if unavailable, a foot you can do a Zig Zag Stitch with, clear if possible.
